3 Reasons Why we all need Jesus...

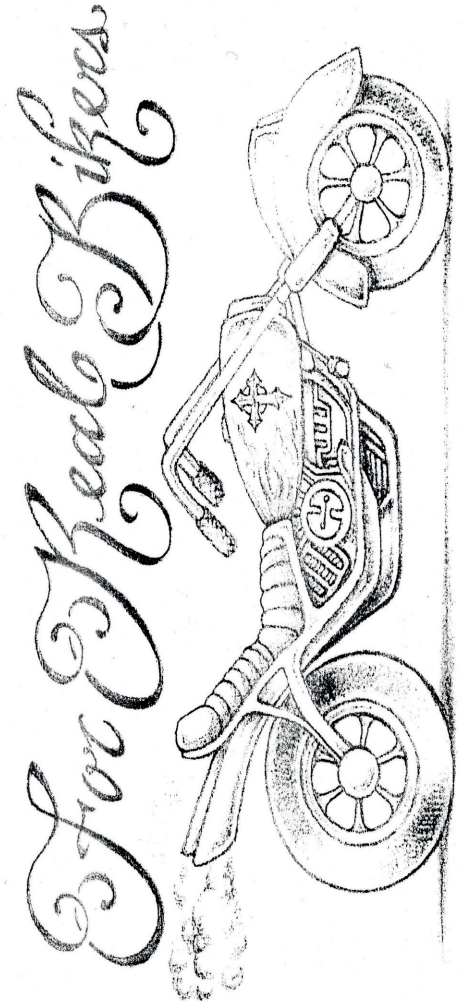
